

- The International Monitoring System and other monitoring systems (e.g., the Ring of Five) see the effects of emissions from isotope production essentially "every day"
- ► The impact of emissions from man-made sources continues to worry of policy makers in Vienna
- The CTBTO Preparatory Commission has continued to have strong interest in the problem


